

# **Guide to Partnering Financially with CCC**

Please find below a brief summary of the 4 funds that CCC has for different purposes and ways to partner financially with our church.

#### 1. Church General Fund

Purpose – The General Fund is used towards the general running of the church including paying stipends to our pastors and salaries to our administration staff, the maintenance costs of our church, ministry expenses and administrative expenses.

Ways to contribute:

- 1) Place your contribution (cash or cheque) into the offertory bag or box during your worship service.
- 2) Electronically transfer (or EFT) your contribution into the main church account with the following account details:

3) Contribute by credit card on the giving page of the CCC website: (<a href="www.chinesechristianchurch.org.au">www.chinesechristianchurch.org.au</a>) or using the Church App (Tithe.ly), and selecting the General giving option.

#### 2. Church Mission Fund

Purpose – The Mission Fund is used to support our local and overseas missionaries, theological students and various mission projects/initiatives.

Ways to contribute:

- 1) Place your contribution (cash or cheque) into the offertory bag or box during your worship service in an envelope clearly marked with "Mission" on it.
- 2) Electronically transfer (or EFT) your contribution into the main church account with the following account details:

# 3. Future Development Fund

Purpose – The Future Development Fund will be used for the following:

- Purchase or lease property for our second location;
- Purchase or lease property for the purpose of a church plant;
- Purchase or lease another property in Milsons Point to allow expansion of ministries.

#### Ways to contribute:

- 1) Place your contribution (cash or cheque) into the offertory bag or box during your worship service in an envelope clearly marked with "Future Development Fund".
- 2) Electronically transfer your contribution into the FD Fund account with the following account details:

# 4. School Building Fund (Tax deductible)

Purpose – The School Building Fund has been established for the purpose of acquisition, construction and maintenance of a building used by the CCC Sunday School and CMC (Children's Ministry Committee).

Please note we do not accept cash as a form of donation into this fund and a tax-deductible receipt will only be issued when we receive a completed School Building Fund form.

#### Ways to contribute:

### 1. 教會常務基金 (General Fund)

目的: 常務基金用於教會的一般運作包括支付教牧團、行政人員的薪金和津貼, 教會的維修費用、事工費用和行政費用。

#### 奉獻方法:

# 3. 未來發展基金 (Future Development Fund)

目的: 未來發展基金將用於以下用途:

- 為教會的第二個地點而購買或租賃另一處物業;
- 為教會植堂而購買或租賃物業;
- 為擴展事工而購買或租賃 Milsons Point 的另一處物業。

### 奉獻方法:

- 1) 請把你的奉獻 (現金或支票) 放進一個註明 "未來發展基金" 的信封,然後在崇拜日中放入奉獻袋 /箱。
- 2) 通過電子轉帳奉獻至以下的未來發展基金帳戶:

### 4. 學校建設基金 (可扣稅) (School Building Fund)

目的: 學校建設基金成立的目的是用來購置, 建設和保養維修教會主日學和基督教青年教育委員會所使用的建築物。

請注意此基金不接受現金捐款,教會必須收到填妥的學校建設基金表格後方能給捐款人發出收據以便扣稅。
